Investment Objective & Strategy

The fund seeks to provide an investment return that approximates as closely as practicable, before expenses, the performance of the Bloomberg® U.S. Aggregate Bond Index over the long term.

The fund is a custom fund that currently invests exclusively in units of a collective investment trust (CIT), which uses an indexing investment approach to track, before expenses, the performance of the Bloomberg® U.S. Aggregate Bond Index, an index designed to measure the performance of the investment grade, US Dollar-denominated, fixed-rate taxable bond market. The index includes U.S. Treasuries, governmentrelated and corporate securities, Mortgage Backed Securities (MBS) (agency fixed-rate pass-throughs), Asset Backed Securities (ABS) and Commercial Mortgage Backed Securities (CMBS) (agency and non-agency). The fund may attempt to invest in the securities comprising the Index in the same proportions as the Index where practicable, but due to the diverse composition of the securities in the Index, it will generally use sampling, may invest in other securities, or employ other techniques to construct the portfolio and manage exposure. It is possible that the fund's return may not match the return of the Index

Category Description: Intermediate Core Bond

Intermediate-term core bond portfolios invest primarily in investment-grade U.S. fixed-income issues including government, corporate, and securitized debt, and hold less than 5% in below-investment-grade exposures. Their durations (a measure of interest-rate sensitivity) typically range between 75% and 125% of the three-year average of the effective duration of the Morningstar Core Bond Index.

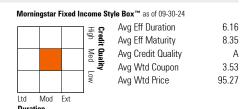
